### School-based After-school Learning and Support Programmes (Programme) 2023/24

Thank you for your confirmation for receiving the School-based Grant (SBG) for the 2023/24 school year. As stipulated in the Circular Memorandum No. 56/2023, a special arrangement is made by considering the annual accounts of the most recent year and the two years before the wake of COVID-19 epidemic of the participating schools for the utilisation of SBG to determine whether schools are eligible for the SBG incentive funding in the 2023/24 school year. I am pleased to inform you that your school is eligible for the incentive funding for having attained 80% or above of the utilisation rate in accordance with the special arrangement. Thus, the grant is calculated at the rate of \$600 per eligible student per annum plus an additional 25% for the SBG discretionary quota. A cash grant of HK\$172,800 will be released to your school for organising activities / complementing services for eligible students.

Please be reminded that the grant is provided to cater for the needs of the eligible disadvantaged students for the 2023/24 school year. For the benefit of the eligible students, please spend the grant within the 2023/24 school year as far as possible.

You are also required to include the Programme in your School Development Plan and upload the programme plan onto your school website by end-October 2023. The actual number of disadvantaged students served and the results of evaluation on the effectiveness of the programmes subsidised by the grant, including students' learning and affective outcomes, should also be reported in your School Report to be uploaded onto the website not later than end-November 2024. The SBG is subject to clawback if your school fails to fulfill the aforesaid requirements. You should also complete the questionnaire of School-based Grant and return it to EDB by end of the school year. For details, please refer to the above-mentioned EDB Circular Memorandum.
